Job Description:

Job responsibilities include:

- Network with state agencies, special education departments in school districts, parent groups, and community organizations to find appropriate candidates
- Assess applicants' suitability for the program, including an interview with the applicant and an in-store assessment
- Train the successful applicant on the job site until the applicant is able to work independently. Intensive training is typically 12 hours per week, for six to eight weeks
- Act as liaison between Ken's Krew, store managers, and staff of our partner corporations to ensure the needs of both the corporation and our workers are being met
- Provide ongoing support to workers in the Ken's Krew program, through regular spot checks at their job sites
- Conduct an ongoing social/education program for Ken's Krew workers about seven evenings per year
